**PROTECTING GOD’S CHILDREN**

Child Abuse Prevention (CAP) is a program selected by the Archdiocese for educating parish adults on ways to prevent child abuse and creating safe environments for children. The program consists of presentations, printed and video-taped materials focusing on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. **EVERY staff member and ALL volunteers 18 years or older, in the parish and school (including all organizations) are mandated by the Archdiocese of Boston to attend a training session ONCE.** The training session is approximately 3 hours in length. Marguerite and St. Rita Parishes. On June 1, Fr. Bob will assume the pastorate at St. Patrick's Parish in Watertown; Fr. Chris will become Parochial Vicar at St. Agnes Parish, Arlington.

On June 1, our Episcopal Vicar, Fr. Arthur Coyle, will be the temporary administrator of both parishes (Ste. Marguerite & St. Rita), until a new pastor is assigned. The new Parochial Vicar for both parishes will be Fr. Garcia Breneville, who will mainly be doing the pastoral work at St. Rita's until a new pastor arrives. Fr. Breneville is a Haitian priest who has been working in the Archdiocese for many years and celebrated his 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this year. Fr. Leo Cormier has graciously offered to provide for the pastoral care at Ste. Marguerite's Parish.

On June 14, Fr. Brian Mahoney will become Pastor of St. Francis Parish. Fr. Bob will continue to administrate St. Francis Parish until that date, but Fr. Jim Lyons, who has decided to remain in Dracut, will provide the pastoral care – daily mass, funerals and any other care.

We realize that there are a lot of changes happening and we appreciate the patience that you show especially to the staffs during this time. God bless you all.
