The parable seeks to help us answer one of life's pressing questions: Where am I going? Am I going up the corporate ladder? Am I going to a better neighborhood? Or am I seeking to do what God desires me to do with my life? As in some of Jesus' other parables involving the well off, there is no demand here that the man sell all of his possessions or immediately dispose of his barns. Rather, it is the "I can do it myself" attitude that comes into question. If that remains our attitude about life, about spirituality, about God, then we, too, may discover that sometime soon, we will move to a new location and we will not be ready for our goal in life: living for Christ and helping others to live for Him.

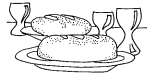
