He reached out and shared His power, with this "unbeliever" and in a single action introduced God's love to the Gentile world. Today's lesson is an example for all of us. Before we mark another request as "not my problem", let's be sure to stop and ask, "who am I excluding from God's love?"

TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FROM FR. MARC

Dear Friends,

As you read this, I am gathering with young-people from all over the world in Madrid, Spain for World Youth Day 2011. Over the last two years, I and the 19 other pilgrims traveling with me, have diligently raised funds and spiritually prepared for this specific event in our faith journey. Through the generosity of many people and the hard work of the members, we raised close to \$60,000.00. I am very grateful to God for all the support we received. In his letter announcing World Youth Day 2011, Pope Benedict wrote: "Now, at a time when Europe greatly needs to rediscover its Christian roots, our meeting will take place in Madrid with the theme: 'Planted and built up in Jesus Christ, firm in the faith' (Col. 2:7). I encourage you to take part in this event which is so important for the Church in Europe and for the Universal Church (Rosica, Columbia, August 2001, p.14)." The Holy Father is calling Catholics, and especially young Catholics, to step out of the shadow of secular culture and publicly rejoice in the faith of Jesus Christ. I ask you to pray for me, and my fellow pilgrims, as we together journey in faith and hopefully inspire and get inspired. I will be away from the parishes from August 12 to August 31.
